## Advance Practice Registered Nurses (APRNs)

A snapshot of the APRN workforce in Hawai'i



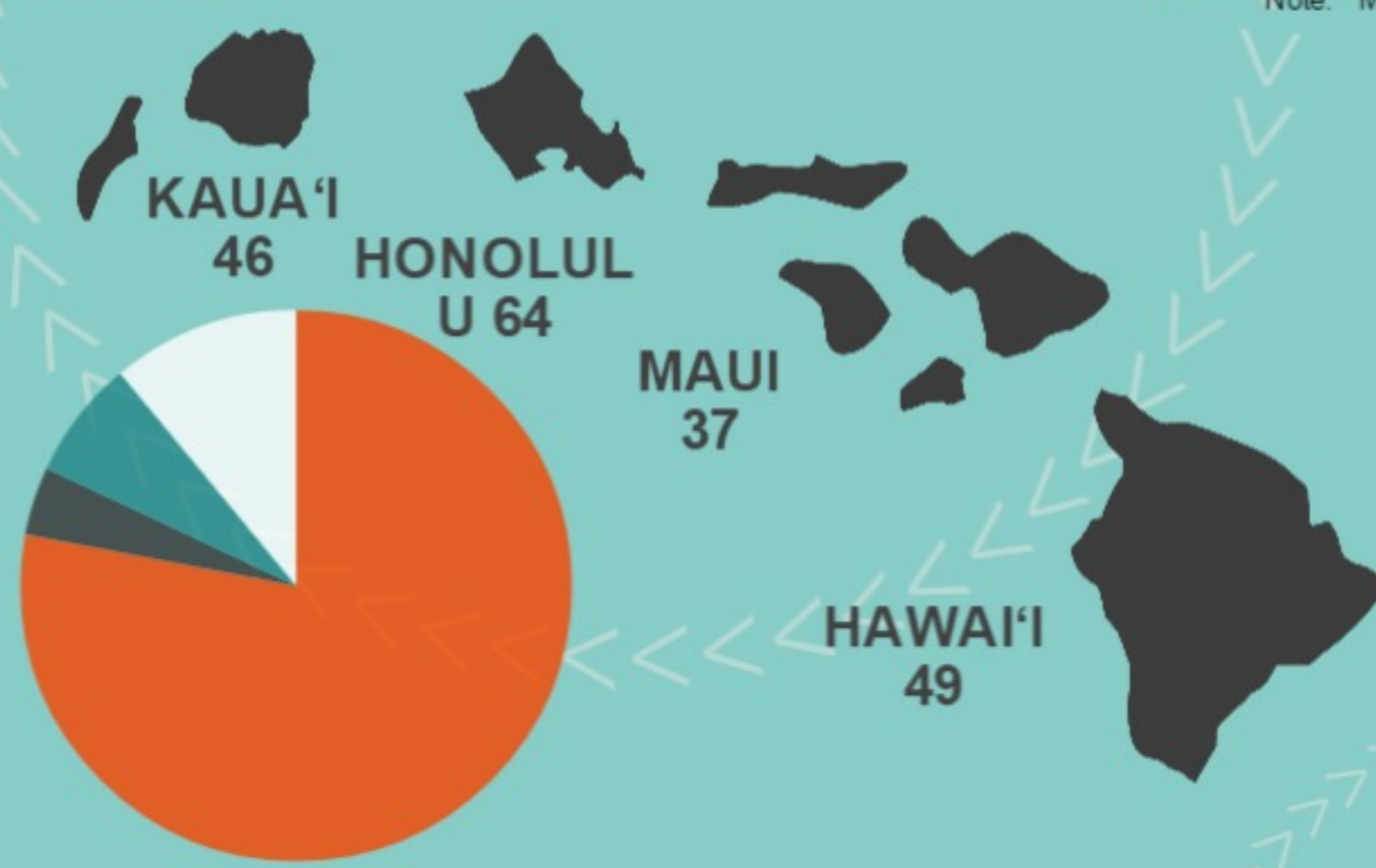
The presenting statistics were performed using the data from the PVL Geo Reports (State of Hawai'i, DCCA). The numbers of nursing licenses were reported by island in the PVL Geo Reports. For this report, the numbers were aggregated by county. Numbers of licensed RNs per 100,000 population were estimated using the postcensal population estimates (the U.S. Census Bureau). Male percent and average age among RNs were estimated using the data from the 2013 Nursing Workforce Survey (Hawai'i State Center for Nursing).

The number of APRN licenses per 100,000 population in Hawai'i increased 2.5 times from 2007 to 2013

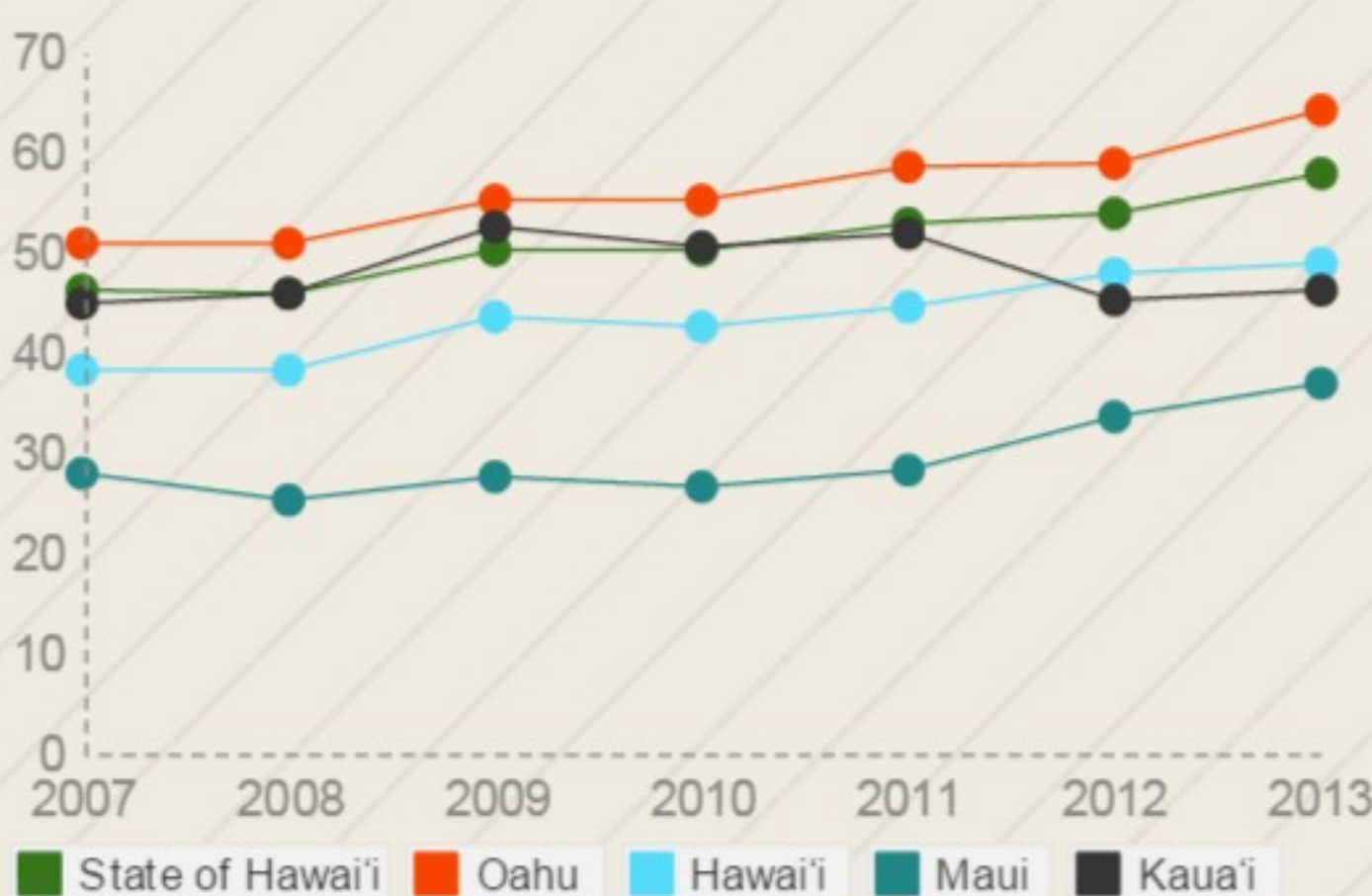

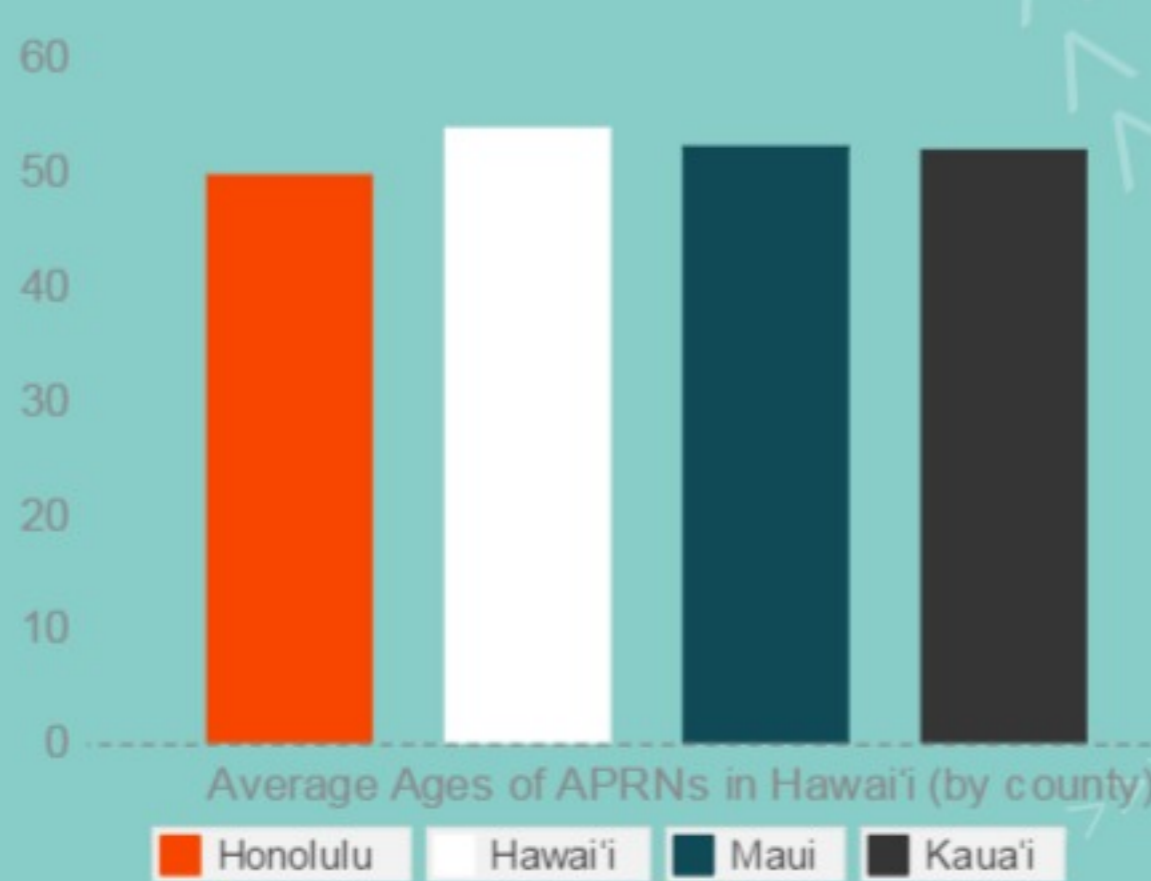
### APRN LICENSES PER 100,000 POPULATION BY COUNTY (2013)
