



ACADEMIC PROGRESSION IN NURSING (APIN)

- **A GRANT FUNDED BY THE ROBERT WOOD JOHNSON FOUNDATION IN COLLABORATION WITH THE TRI-COUNCIL ON NURSING**
 - An initiative of the Campaign for Nursing to improve healthcare through nursing
 - Focused on implementation of the Institute of Medicine (IOM) recommendations on the Future of Nursing
 - Hawai'i one of 9 states to receive initial APIN grants

- **GOAL TO INCREASE THE % OF BSN PREPARED NURSES IN HAWAI'I**
 - Brings together leaders and stakeholders from academic institutions, employer groups and the community to develop, implement and evaluate strategies, programs and policies

- **STRATEGIC WORKING GROUPS**
 - **HAWAI'I ACTION COALITION** meets quarterly and serves as the steering committee for the APIN grant. Focuses on increasing funding, making policy changes and engaging a large segment of the community
 - **ACADEMIC COUNCIL** meets monthly and collaborates on the development, implementation and evaluation of a shared statewide baccalaureate curriculum in nursing
 - **EMPLOYERS COUNCIL** meets quarterly to develop initiatives and incentives to increase the % of baccalaureate prepared nurses in their organizations
