Traditional mailing costs can be prohibitive DCCA PVL's ongoing allocation structure for nursing license fees may be a barrier to directing any fee increase revenues to HSCN. Board membership is valuable and increases reach Stakeholders comprised of professional organizations and employers expand reach by trickle down. Stakeholder meetings and working with organizations on communication is important. Engagement of the Legislature is key to increase fees and establish communications system to; Reduce misinformation Demonstrate our value to nurses and achieve buy-in Reduce opposition testimony There are barriers present for DCCAPVL to the sharing resources/platforms, such as mailing lists. Even activities approved or mandated by Legislature can be complex and encounter many barriers to implementation. CEJAC demonstrated that in order to be successful; Buy –in from all stakeholders is important; including but not limited to Government Agencies, Legislature, professional organizations, Boards, Employee unions, Employers and community members.
