

2023 Hawai'i Nursing Workforce Supply Statewide Data Tables by License

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About the Sample:

The data contained in the tables in this report are the responses of 8,375 nurses employed in nursing license-relevant roles in the state of Hawai'i between April and June of 2023. The full description of the study method is available in the 2023 Hawai'i Nursing Workforce Supply Survey Method Report.

Notations and Symbols the Tables:

Data have been suppressed (marked with a double asterisk **) in cases where cell sizes were less than 5. In cases where the cell size was 5 or greater and the corresponding percentage rounded to 0% are displayed as <1%.

Estimated Counts:

All tables contain estimated counts of the number of nurses in the Hawai'i workforce who are represented by each percentage. A description of how counts were estimated is described in the Method Report linked above. All counts have been rounded to the nearest 5 nurses. In cases where estimated counts represent a subset of nurses, the sum of the counts may not sum to the count corresponding to 100% of the nurses in the subset. The discrepancy is due to rounding.

Multiple Select Questions:

In tables or variables that were collected as multiple select questions (e.g., respondents could select more than one option), the sum of percentages may exceed 100%. These variables are appropriately marked.
