



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


















HNRP and TTP Updates

Grants — Transition-to-Specialty / Good Jobs

Overview:

Grant Period: Jan 2023-September 2024 (with retroactive enrollment)

HSCN will assist HAH in the collection of data for Stipends

Transition-to-Specialty Curriculum

The Center secured for 48 industry-leading specialty training curriculum packages in 25 specialty care areas for the HNRP partners.

HTTP curriculum addresses specialties identified in the Assessment of Specialty Nurse Needs for Hawai'i, in greatest need for incumbent nurse development. (Hawai'i State Center for Nursing, 2022).

In October of 2023, the Center launched the Hawai'i Collaborative, an internet marketplace to allow HNRP partners to purchase educational curricula at a discount.

By the close of the grant in September of 2024,

The HNRP aims to provide 845 employer-based transition-to-specialty courses to Hawai'i nurses.

Participating partners will receive reimbursement for 100% of tuition and curriculum during the grant period.
