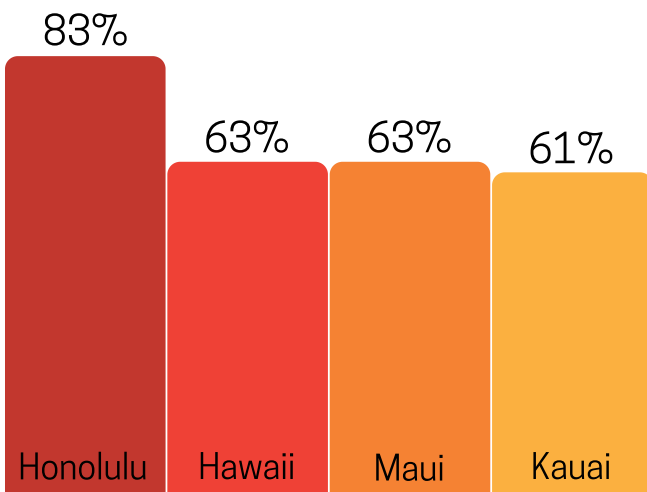

BSN+ PREPAREDNESS

78% of Hawaii nurses are prepared at the baccalaureate level or higher.

 The national rate is **59%** (Campaign for Action, 2021).

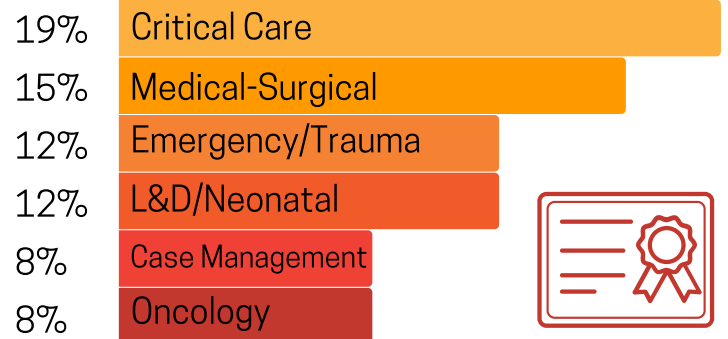
BSN + BY COUNTY

1 in 3 registered nurses hold a national certification.

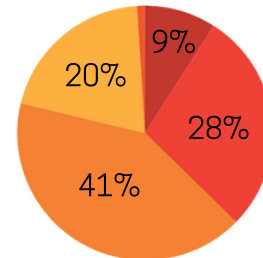

CONTINUING COMPETENCY

We asked nurses to tell us about all continuing competency activities they completed.



85% completed 30 continuing education contact hours.



7% spent 120+ hours precepting nursing students.



23% of all nurses who graduated within the last 10 years completed a nurse residency program.

EBP EDUCATION

57% of nurses have received formal education on evidence-based practice. Recent graduates are more likely to have received EBP education.
