ABOUT THE CENTER

The Center was established in 2003 by legislative mandate. We are dedicated to ensuring Hawaii is the best place for nurses to work and believe that excellence in nursing practice leads to quality care for the people of Hawaii.

We develop and maintain statewide programs that impact the entire nursing workforce pipeline.



Nursing Students & New Graduates

CLINICAL PLACEMENT COLLABORATIVE

Since 2012, we have brought together schools and healthcare organizations to facilitate nearly 35,000 clinical experiences.



67% of nurses who graduated after 2009 have received formal EBP Training.

EBP FOR EDUCATORS

We partner with all schools of nursing across the state to develop their faculty into competent educators of evidence-based practice.

HAWAII STATE SIMULATION COLLABORATIVE

We provide a forum for academic and clinical nurse educators to share best-practices related to simulation education.

HAWAII NURSE RESIDENCY COLLABORATIVE

Since 2012, we have helped employers support over 1,300 new graduate nurses' transition from school to practice.

EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICE

The Center has created a culture of EBP by developing programs for clinicians, nurse educators, and healthcare leaders. Over 500 participants have attended these programs.

SUCCESS PAYS CERTIFICATION PROGRAM


We give nurses the opportunity to achieve national certification without financial risk. This program is open to 100% of nurses in Hawaii.

WRITING WORKSHOP

Since 2013, we have provided intensive mentorship to help nurses prepare manuscripts for publication. Over 80 nurses have benefitted from this program.

CONTINUING NURSING EDUCATION

In 2019, the Center became an accredited provider of continuing nursing education. Over the past two years, we have awarded over 6,700 contact hours.

CONTINUING COMPETENCY



ACADEMIC PROGRESSION IN NURSING

Since 2012, the Center has brought together academic and employer partners to ensure a highly educated nursing workforce.



78% of Hawaii nurses are prepared at the baccalaureate level or higher.

WORKFORCE DATA

The Center's collection and reporting of workforce data provides workforce planners with the information they need to develop plans that ensure we have enough nurses to care for our communities.
